CONSTITUTION OF INDIA:

No.RTR-1974/31939-MED-3: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and supersession of all existing rules and orders issued in this behalf and in force in the State or any part thereof, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following recruitment rules for the post of DIRECTOR OF AYURVED in the State of Maharashtra, namely:

1. (1) these rules may be called the Director of Ayurved (Maharashtra) Recruitment Rules, 1975.
  - (2) they shall come into force on the 20th day of December, 1975.
2. Appointment to the post of Director of Ayurved (hereinafter referred to "as the said post") may be made either -

- (a) by promotion from amongst persons holding the posts of Deans of Government Ayurvedic colleges and Professors of Ayurvedic subjects in Government Ayurvedic colleges possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment to the said post by nomination **in the following order, that is to say -**

1. Deans, and
2. Professors

OR

- (b) by nomination from amongst the candidates, who -

- (i) possess one of the qualifications mentioned in Part A, B, or C of the schedule appended to the Maharashtra Medical Practitioners' Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.

- (ii) have good knowledge of English and Hindi.

- (iii) possess combined experience as Dean or Professor of a Government recognised Ayurvedic college or experience in administrative posts in the Department of Ayurved for not less than seven (7) years or less than ten (10) years respectively acquired after obtaining the qualification in sub-clause (i) of **clause (b).**

(iv) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra are not more than 45-years of age provided, that the age limit may be relaxed in favour of any candidate possessing exceptional qualifications or experience.

Provided, further that, preference may be given to any candidate who possess a Post-graduate Degree of a recognised University in any branch of Ayurved or a Post-graduate Diploma such as F.F.A.M. of the Maharashtra Faculty of Ayurvedic and Unani Systems of Medicine or equivalent qualification or has good research work in Ayurved to his credit.

(c) a candidate appointed to the said post by NOMINATION shall be on probation for a period of 2-years.

3. A candidate appointed to the said post by promotion or by nomination shall have to pass the prescribed examinations in Marathi and Hindi according to the rules governing such examinations unless he has already passed them or is exempted from passing them.

4. A candidate appointed to the said post shall be required to get himself registered under the Maharashtra Medical Practitioners Act, 1961 (Mah. XXVIII of 1961) before joining the appointment unless, he is already so registered.

No. RTR. 1286/558/CR-72/86/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf and in force in the State or any part thereof, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Dean in the Government Ayurvedic Colleges, Maharashtra Ayurvedic, Service Class I, under the Directorate of Ayurved of the Government of Maharashtra namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Dean, Government Ayurvedic College (Recruitment) Rules, 1988.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) "Central Act" means the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970);

(b) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission ;

(c) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Maharashtra ;

(d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra ;

(e) "Maharashtra Act" means the Maharashtra Medical Practitioners Act, 1961 (Mah. XXVIII of 1961).

3. Appointment to the post of Dean in the Government Ayurvedic Colleges, under the Directorate shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of election from amongst the persons holding the post of Professor in the Government Ayurvedic College having not less than five years service in that post, and possessing qualifications mentioned in the sub-clause (ii) of clause (b) of this rule ;

(b) by nomination from amongst the persons who—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 45 years of age ;

(ii) possess any qualification mentioned in parts A, A, I, B or C in the Schedule to the Maharashtra Act, or an equivalent qualification, specified by the Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi, from time to time, under the Central Act and possess post-graduate qualification in Ayurved obtained from an Ayurvedic institution or college recognised by Government or a statutory university ;

(iii) possess minimum ten years' experience of teaching in any Ayurvedic College, gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of this clause out of which five years experience shall be in the teaching of post-graduate students in the capacity of a Professor in an Ayurvedic subject ; and

(iv) have adequate knowledge of Marathi, Hindi and Sanskrit language ;

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed on the recommendations of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualification or experience or both.

4. Appointment by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50 : 50.

5. A person appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. A person appointed on the post of Dean shall be debarred from doing private practice but shall be paid non-practising allowance in lieu of it, according to the rules made by Government in that behalf.

7. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass examinations in Marathi and Hindi according to the rules made by Government in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing these examinations.

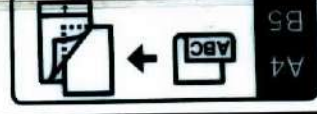
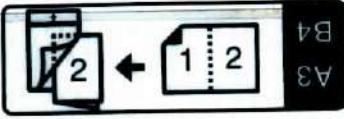
8. A person selected to the post shall have to get his name registered in the register maintained under the Maharashtra Act or under the Central Act, as the case may be, before joining the post unless he has already been so registered.

9. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, if in the opinion of Government the exigencies of service so require, the Government may, after consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointment to the post of Dean, Maharashtra Ayurvedic Service, Class I, in relaxation of the ratio prescribed in rule 4 for recruitment by nomination and promotion.

10. A person appointed to the post shall be liable to be transferred anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

Provided further that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government, on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualification or experience or both.

4. A person appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. A person appointed to the post by promotion, transfer or nomination shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing these examinations.

6. Appointment to the posts by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 1 : 1.

7. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

8. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, if in the opinion of Government the exigencies of the service so require, the Government may, after consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointment to the post in relaxation of the percentage prescribed in these rules for recruitment by nomination.

No. RTR. 2782/627/CR-50/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules

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regulating recruitment to the post of Deputy Director of Homoeopathy, in Maharashtra Ayurveda Services, Class I, in the Directorate of Ayurveda under the Medical Education and Drugs Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Director of Homoeopathy, Maharashtra Ayurveda Services, Class I (Recruitment) Rules, 1986.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise—

(a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission ;

(b) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Ayurveda, Maharashtra State ;

(c) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Deputy Director of Homoeopathy in the Directorate shall be made either—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority, subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the post of Administrative Medical Officer (Homoeopathy), Class II, having not less than three years service in that post and possessing qualifications prescribed for appointment by nomination in sub-clause (ii) of clause (b) of this rule ; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than 35 years of age ;

(ii) possess any one of the qualifications mentioned in the First Schedule to the Bombay Homoeopathic and Biochemic Practitioners' Act, (1969) (Bom. XII of 1960), or any of the qualifications included in the Second Schedule to the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 (59 of 1974) ;

(iii) possess not less than seven years' professional experience of homoeopathic hospitals or five years' experience in the post of Principal, or Professor and Head of Department of a Homoeopathic College, gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) above ; and

(iv) have adequate knowledge of Hindi, English and Marathi so as to be able to read, write and speak the languages with facility :

Provided that, preference may be given to candidates who—

(a) possess qualification or practical experience in hospital administration,

(b) have published original research papers or books in Homoeopathy :

Provided further that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualification or experience or both.

4. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.



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5. A person selected for appointment to the post shall be required to get himself registered under the Bombay Homoeopathic and Biochemic Practitioners' Act, 1959, before joining the service, unless he is already so registered.

6. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or by nomination shall be required to pass examinations in Marathi and Hindi according to the rules made in that behalf unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing such examinations.

No. RTR. 1884/250/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Chief Administrative Officer, in General State Services, Class I, in the Directorate of Ayurved, under the Medical Education and Drugs Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Chief Administrative Officer, in the Directorate of Ayurved, G. S. S., Cl. I (Recruitment) Rules, 1987.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise.—

(a) "Commission" means Maharashtra Public Service Commission;

(b) "Degree" means degree of a statutory university;

(c) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Ayurved, Maharashtra State;

(d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Chief Administrative Officer, in the Directorate, shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion on the basis of Seniority subject to fitness from amongst the officers holding the post of Administrative Officer, in the Directorate, having not less than three years' service in that post; or

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(b) by nomination from amongst candidates, who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 40 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree in Arts, Science, Commerce or Law;

(iii) have administrative or executive experience for a period of not less than seven years in a gazetted post, under Government or a comparable post in semi-Government organisation or local body or commercial establishment gained after acquiring qualification in sub-clause (ii) above; and

(iv) have adequate knowledge of Marathi so as to be able to speak, read and write the language with facility:

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates possessing exceptional qualifications or experience or both:

Provided further that preference may be given to candidates conversant with Government Services Rules and Regulations particularly the Maharashtra Civil Services Rules and the Financial Rules and accounting procedure and other relevant Acts and Rules.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (iii) of clause (b) of Rule 3 above, if at any stage of selection, the Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to S.C.s including S.C. converts to Buddhism, S.T.s and D.T./N.T.s, then the Commission may, in the matter of such selection, relax the requirement in respect of the period of experience and select suitable candidates belonging to such castes or tribes.

5. Appointment to the post by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50:50.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, if in the opinion of Government, the exigencies of services so required, Governments may, after consultation with the Commission wherever necessary, make appointment to the post of Chief Administrative Officer, General State Service, Class I in relaxation of the percentage prescribed in these rules for recruitment by nomination/promotion.

7. A person appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

8. A person appointed to the post whether by promotion or by nomination shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in this behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing them.

9. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the Maharashtra State.

(iii) have two years experience gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) in Bio-chemical Laboratory requiring knowledge of techniques like spectrophotometry, electrophoresis and chromatography, and

(iv) have experience of research involving development of methods and techniques in clinical Bio-chemistry :

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

4. A person appointed to the post shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in this behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing them.

6. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

१. या नियमांना शासकीय आयुर्वेदिक महाविद्यालयातील महाराष्ट्र आयुर्वेदिक सेवा वर्ग एक आणि वर्ग दोन यांमधील प्राध्यापक, प्रपाठक, अधिव्याख्याता (सेवाप्रवेश) नियम, १९८८ असे म्हणता येईल.

२. या नियमांमध्ये, संदर्भानुसार, अन्यथा अर्थ अपेक्षित नसेल तर,—

- (अ) "पदवी" म्हणजे वैधानिक विद्यापीठाची पदवी;
- (ब) "संचालनालय" म्हणजे महाराष्ट्र शासनाचे आयुर्वेद संचालनालय;
- (क) "शासन" म्हणजे महाराष्ट्र शासन;
- (ड) "मान्यताप्राप्त संस्था" म्हणजे महाराष्ट्र वैद्यक व्यवसायी अधिनियम, १९६१ (१९६१ चा महाराष्ट्र अधिनियम क्रमांक अठ्ठावीस) याच्या कलम २७ अन्वये मान्यता दिलेली आयुर्वेदिक संस्था अथवा महाविद्यालय;
- (ई) "अनुसूची" म्हणजे या नियमांना जोडलेली अनुसूची.

३. संचालनालयाखालील शासकीय आयुर्वेदिक महाविद्यालयातील महाराष्ट्र आयुर्वेदिक सेवा, वर्ग एक, यामधील प्राध्यापक या पदावर करावयाची नेमणूक ही पुढीलपैकी कोणत्याही एका प्रकारे करता येईल :—

(अ) प्रपाठकाच्या पदावर काम करित असलेल्या व ज्या व्यक्तीकडे या नियमाच्या खंड (ब) मध्ये नामनिर्देशनाद्वारे नियुक्तीसाठी विहित केलेली अर्हता व अनुभव असेल अशा व्यक्तींमधून निवड तत्वावर योग्य व्यक्तीस पदोन्नती देऊन; अथवा

(ब) ज्या उमेदवारांच्या बाबतीत पुढील शर्ती पूर्ण होत असतील अशा उमेदवारांमधून नामनिर्देशनाद्वारे नियुक्ती करता येईल :—

(एक) उमेदवाराचे वय ४० वर्षांपेक्षा जास्त नसावे; मात्र जो उमेदवार अशोदर-पासूनच शासकीय सेवेत असेल त्याला ही शर्त लागू होणार नाही;

(दोन) अनुसूचीतील क्रमांक (१) च्या नोंदीपुढे नमूद केल्याप्रमाणे त्याने अर्हता व अनुभव प्राप्त केलेला असावा; आणि

(तीन) त्याला इंग्रजी, मराठी, संस्कृत व हिंदी या भाषांचे पुरेसे ज्ञान असावे म्हणजेच, त्यानुसार तो त्या भाषा सहज रीत्या वाचण्यास, लिहिण्यास व बोलण्यास समर्थ असला पाहिजे.

1. These rules may be called the Assistant Director of Ayurved, Maharashtra Ayurved Service, Class II, in the Directorate of Ayurved (Recruitment) Rules, 1987.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise—

- (a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission ;
- (b) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Ayurved, Maharashtra State ;
- (c) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra ;
- (d) "Recognised institution" means an institution recognised by the Government.

3. Appointment to the post of Assistant Director of Ayurved, Class II, in the Directorate shall be made either—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst persons holding the post of Vaidya I/c. Panchkarma having not less than three years service in that post, and possessing qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination in sub-clause (ii) and (iv) of clause (c) of this rule ; or

(b) by transfer of a suitable person from the cadre of Resident Medical Officer under the Directorate having not less than three years service as the Resident Medical Officer and possessing qualifications prescribed for appointment by nomination in sub-clause (ii) of clause (c) of this rule ; or

(c) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 40 years of age ;

(ii) possess one of the qualifications included in Parts A, A1, B and C of the Schedule to the Maharashtra Medical Practitioners Act, 1961 ;

(iii) have adequate knowledge of English, Marathi and Sanskrit ; and

(iv) have administrative experience gained after acquiring the qualifications mentioned in sub-clause (ii) above for not less than three years in an Ayurvedic Hospital or College or in a recognised institution concerned with the promotion of Ayurved or practice thereof :

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government, on the recommendation of the Commission, in favour of candidates having exceptional qualification or experience or both.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (iv) of clause (c) of rule 3, if at any stage of selection the Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Castes converts to Buddhism, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes and Nomadic Tribes, then, the Commission, may, in the matter of such selection relax the requirement in respect of the period of experience are select suitable candidates belonging to such castes or tribes.

5. Appointment to the post by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50:50.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, if in the opinion of Government, the exigencies of service so require, Government may, after consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointments to the post of Assistant Director of Ayurved in the Directorate in relaxation of the percentage prescribed in these rules for recruitment by nomination.

7. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

8. A candidate selected for appointment shall be required to get himself registered under the Maharashtra Medical Practitioners Act, 1961, before joining the service unless he is already so registered.

9. A person appointed to the post whether by nomination or by promotion shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he had already passed or has exempted from passing these examinations.

10. A person appointed to the post shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India, anywhere in or outside India for a period of not less than four years (inclusive of the period spent in training, if any) on such conditions, as may be determined from time to time by the Government of India :

Provided that, such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment and ordinarily after he has attained the age of forty-five years.

11. A person appointed to the post shall be liable to be transferred anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 35 years of age ;

No. HMO. 1076/3995-PH-4, amended under No. HMO-1080/1612/PH-4, dated 10th August 1981 and Medical Education and Drugs Department No. HMO. 2182/1256/MED-2, dated the 10th July, 1986.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating the recruitment and conditions of service of Honorary Medical Officers, Honorary Consultants and Professor Emeritus attached to the Government Hospitals in the State of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. *Short title, commencement and application.*—(1) These rules may be called the Maharashtra Honorary Medical Officers (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1976.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publications in the *Official Gazette*.

(3) They shall apply to Honorary Medical Officers, Honorary Consultants and Professor Emeritus attached to the Government Hospitals of all description in the State of Maharashtra.

2. *Definitions.*—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires :—

(a) "department" means any specialised activity in a Government Hospital, recognised as such by the Government and consisting of one and more units of that speciality;

(b) "Director"—

(i) in respect of allopathic teaching hospitals; means the Director of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State;

(ii) in respect of allopathic non-teaching hospitals, means the Director of Health Services, Maharashtra State;

(iii) in respect of Ayurvedic and also Homoeopathic teaching and non-teaching hospitals, means the Director of Ayurveda, Maharashtra State;

(c) "Honorary Consultant" means a medical officer appointed under these rules as Honorary Consultant;

(d) "Honorary Medical Officer" means a Medical Officer appointed under these rules as Honorary Medical Officer or in a teaching hospital as Honorary Professor, and includes a medical officer appointed as Honorary Assistant Medical officer and in a teaching hospital as Honorary Assistant Professor. Any such officer may be or may not be in receipt of Honorarium;

(e) "Municipal Corporation Area" means the area within the jurisdiction of a Municipal Corporation established under the Bombay Municipal Corporation Act, the Bombay Provincial Municipal Corporations Act, 1949; or the City of Nagpur Corporation Act, 1948.

(f) "Professor Emeritus" means a medical officer appointed under these rules as Professor Emeritus;

(g) "Superintendent" means the head or principal medical officer in administrative charge of the Hospital, and in the case of a teaching hospital includes a Dean or Civil Surgeon or any other medical officer in-charge, as the case may be;

(h) "Teaching Hospital" means a Government Hospital where facilities for imparting education in different branches of medicine are also provided;

(i) "Unit" means a section in a Government Hospital consisting of Honorary Medical Officers, who work there in respect of any specified branch of medicine for treating patients.

3. *Appointment of Honorary Medical Officers and Honorary Professors.*—(1) Appointment to the post of Honorary Assistant Medical Officer in a non-teaching Hospital and Honorary Assistant Professor in a teaching Hospital shall be made by the State Government by nomination.

Provided that, the Honorary Assistant Professor in teaching Hospital, shall be designated by the State Government as Honorary Associate Professor after completion of five years service as Honorary Assistant Professor, on the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State.

(2) Appointment to the post of Honorary Medical Officers in a non-teaching Hospital shall be made by promotion from amongst Honorary Assistant Medical Officers in the same or allied discipline from the seniority list of Honorary Assistant Medical Officers in that hospital as hereinafter provided:

Provided that, where in any hospital or a class of hospitals, no appointment of Honorary Assistant Medical Officer is made, any vacancy to the post of Honorary Medical Officer shall be filled in by nomination.

(3) Appointment to the post of Honorary Professor in a teaching Hospital shall be made by promotion from amongst Honorary Associate Professors in the same discipline from the seniority list of Honorary Associate Professor or/Honorary Assistant Professor in that particular teaching Hospital as hereinafter provided:

Provided that, where in any hospital and in any particular discipline, there are no Honorary Associate Professor, the State Government may appoint seniormost Honorary Assistant Professor in the same hospital and in the same discipline as Honorary Professor on the basis of recommendation of the Director of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State, in relaxation of the condition that the appointment to the post of Honorary Professor shall be made from amongst Honorary Associate Professors.

Provided further that, where in any hospital and in any particular discipline, no appointment of Honorary Associate Professor or Honorary Assistant Professor is made, any vacancy to the post of Honorary shall be filled in by nomination.

(4) All appointments of Honorary Medical Officers and Honorary Professor shall be notified in the "Official Gazette".

4. *Qualifications.*—A person shall not be qualified for appointment as Honorary Assistant Medical Officer or Honorary Medical Officer—

(a) in any allopathic teaching hospital, unless he possesses—

(i) a degree of Doctor of Medicine or Master of Surgery of any University established by law in any part of India or holds equivalent qualifications from Universities recognised by the Medical Council of India as Specified in the Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956; and

(ii) for the post of Honorary Assistant Medical Officer, three years' teaching experience in the respective subject in a teaching institution recognised by the University to which the said institution is affiliated;

(iii) for the post of Honorary Medical Officer, five years' teaching experience in the respective subject, in a teaching institution recognised by the University to which the said institution is affiliated; "

(b) in any allopathic non-teaching Hospital, unless he holds a postgraduate degree or diploma in the respective subject, being a medical qualifications included in any of the schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and which is recognised under that Act;

(c) in any Ayurvedic or Homoeopathic Hospital, unless he possesses qualifications recognised by the State Government for appointment to the post of Professors, preferably having post-graduate qualifications;

(d) unless he is a registered practitioner within the meaning of the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965 or the Maharashtra Medical Practitioners Act, 1961, or the Bombay Homoeopathic and Bio-chemic Practitioners Act, 1959, as the case may be; and he does not at the time of his application hold any honorary post, part-time or full-time at any other institution at hours and dates which would conflict with the hours and dates of duties of the post for which he may be selected;

(e) unless he is a registered practitioner as stated in clause (d) above and he does not hold more than one appointment, honorary or otherwise, in any Government or non Government Hospital or College.

5. *Preparation and maintenance of waiting lists.*—(1) On the basis of estimates of vacancies likely to arise and as recommended by the Director from time to time, the State Government may cause to be prepared and maintained a waiting list of suitable persons to be nominated as Honorary Assistant Medical Officers or Honorary Medical Officers, as the case may be.

(2) Such waiting lists shall be prepared in the order of seniority as per the ranking secured by the candidates at the time of selection. Separate waiting lists shall be maintained for each of the municipal corporation areas and each of the Districts (excluding the municipal corporation areas, if any). There shall be separate waiting lists for teaching and non-teaching hospital. All vacancies, whether permanent or casual, shall be filled strictly in accordance with the respective waiting lists. Any offer for appointment made as per waiting list if refused shall render the candidate liable for his name being struck off from the waiting list.

(3) All such waiting lists shall remain in force for a period of three years. For every subsequent period of three years, fresh waiting lists shall be prepared and maintained by a fresh selection of the candidates.

6. *Proportion of Honorary Medical Officers to full-time Medical Officers.*—(1) The number of Honorary Medical Officers in different units in teaching Hospital shall not exceed 50 per cent of the total number of teaching posts in those units in the subject of discipline.

(2) The Honorary Assistant Medical Officers holding office on the date of commencement of these rules shall be eligible for promotion to the posts of Honorary Medical Officers when a vacancy arises, if such promotion does not cause the honorary units to exceed the 50 per cent limit.

(3) No Honorary Medical Officer holding a regular tenure appointment on the date of commencement of these rules shall be discontinued from the post held by him, unless the post to which he is appointed was in lieu of the full-time post.

(4) Before any order discontinuing the appointment of any Honorary Medical Officer is issued, a notice of three months shall be given to the persons affected.

(5) In the non-teaching Hospitals there shall be no stipulation of reservation of 50 per cent posts in the units for Honorary Medical Officers, but on the basis of recommendations made by the Director from time to time, the State Government may fix the number of posts of Honorary Medical Officers which may be attached to individual non-teaching Hospitals, having regard to the availability or otherwise of full time Medical Officers, in a particular discipline at such Hospital. Whenever a full-time Medical Officer in a particular discipline is appointed, the State Government may abolish the post of Honorary Medical Officer for that discipline attached to the non-teaching Hospital concerned and discontinue the appointment of Honorary Medical Officer appointed to that post by giving him notice of three months.

(6) Notwithstanding anything contained in this rule, where in a particular department attached to a teaching Hospital, there are more than 3 units, then not less than 2 units shall be manned by full-time Professors or Associate Professors, as the case may be.

(7) Every full-time Professor including Associate Professor and every Honorary Medical Officer attached to a teaching Hospital shall be in charge of an independent unit and likewise every full-time Honorary Medical Officer in charge of a discipline and an Honorary Medical Officer attached to such a discipline at a non-teaching Hospital shall be in charge of an independent unit.

7. *Age-Limit.*—The appointment of Honorary Medical Officer shall not be subject to any age limit, except that no Honorary Medical Officer shall be appointed or continued in office after he attains the age of fifty-eight years.

8. *Tenure of Office.*—(1) The tenure of office of every Honorary Medical Officer shall be five years in the first instance, after completing the probationary period of one year to the satisfaction of the State Government.

(2) Subject to the provisions of the last preceding rule, the State Government may, after consulting such authorities including the Director as it deems necessary, from time to time, renew the appointment of any Honorary Medical Officer for a further term of five years. Such renewal shall be notified in the *Official Gazette*.

(3) The appointment of all Honorary Medical Officers shall be during the pleasure of the State Government. Any such appointment shall be liable to be terminated by the State Government, after holding such enquiry as it deems fit. Before any such order is made against any Honorary Medical Officer, a notice of three months shall be given to him.

(4) Any Honorary Medical Officer may, by giving notice of three months in writing, resign his office; but he shall stand relieved of the post only from the date of acceptance of the resignation by the State Government.

9. *Honorarium.*—(1) Every Honorary Medical Officer (including Honorary Assistant Medical Officer) attached to any teaching Hospital shall be paid an honorarium of Rs. 250 per month.

(2) Every Honorary Medical Officer attached to a non-teaching Hospital shall be paid an honorarium of Rs. 150 per month and every Honorary Assistant Medical Officer attached to such Hospital shall be paid an honorarium of Rs. 100 per month.

(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1) and (2), the State Government may, in any teaching or non-teaching Hospital, appoint Honorary Assistant Medical Officer or Honorary Medical Officer, without payment of any honorarium.

10. *Hours of attendance.*—(1) *Teaching Hospitals.*—(a) Every Honorary Medical Officer shall put on a minimum of four hours of work every day, with a quantifiable period of 24 hour per working week. This shall include both teaching and clinical work, as the case may be, but shall not include time spent on answering emergency calls.

(b) This quantum of 24 hours per working week shall be suitably distributed during the working week excluding Sundays. Such distribution shall be determined in advance once every six months by the Superintendent, in consultation with the Honorary Medical Officer as far as possible, and in the best interest of the Hospital concerned. The Time-table so drawn up shall be duly notified on the notice-board of the Hospital permanently. The Honorary Medical Officer shall be available for teaching or clinical duty as the case may be, as per time-table, and any authorised departure therefrom shall be treated as absence without leave and will render the Honorary Medical Officer liable for disciplinary action under these rules. Any Honorary Medical Officer aggrieved by any time table drawn up by the Superintendent may prefer an appeal in writing to the Director, within seven days from the date on which the time-table is first notified, and the decision of the Director in that behalf shall be final.

(2) *Non-Teaching Hospitals.*—(a) The hours of attendance of every Honorary Medical Officer shall be such as may be fixed by the Superintendent, who shall draw up a time-table. Such time-table shall be drawn up in advance at the beginning of the term of the Honorary Medical Officer and shall hold good for his entire term.

(b) The time-table so drawn up shall be duly notified on the notice-board of the Hospital. The Honorary Medical Officer shall be available for duty as per the time-table and any unauthorised departure from the time-table so fixed shall be treated as absence without leave and will render the Honorary Medical Officer liable for disciplinary action under these rules. Any Honorary Medical Officer aggrieved by any time-table so drawn up by the Superintendent may prefer an appeal in writing to the Director, within seven days from the date on which the time-table is first notified and the decision of the Director in that behalf shall be final.

11. *Weekly off day.*—In addition to Sunday, every Honorary Medical Officer shall be entitled to have a day off every week. Such day shall be so indicated in the time-table to be drawn up by the Superintendent under the last preceding rule.

12. *Leave to Honorary Medical Officer.*—(1) Every Honorary Medical Officer shall be entitled to privilege leave for fourteen days every year and a special casual leave not exceeding fourteen days in a year for the purpose of studies, or for attending any conference. He shall also be entitled to ten days casual leave in a year, so however, that such casual leave shall not be granted for more than three days at a time.

(2) (i) any leave under sub-rule (1) for attending conference in India shall be granted by the Superintendent with the prior approval of the Director.

(ii) Any other leave under sub-rule (1) shall be granted by the Superintendent;

(iii) All leave granted under sub-rule (1) shall be with honorarium.

(3) The Director may grant special leave to any Honorary Medical Officer upto a period of six months without any honorarium, provided such leave does not exceed beyond the expiration of the tenure of office of the Honorary Medical Officer and the Honorary Medical Officer has completed three years service as such officer.

(4) In cases not falling under sub-rule (3), the leave shall be granted by the Director, with the previous approval of the State Government.

(5) Ordinarily, in the case of Honorary Medical Officer who has not completed three year of service, his request for leave under sub-rule (3) or (4) shall not be considered by the Director or the State Government, unless there are special reasons which shall be recorded in writing.

(6) Any unauthorised absence other than casual leave shall render the Honorary Medical Officer liable for disciplinary action.

13. *Appointment in leave vacancies.*—Appointments in leave vacancies of Assistant Honorary Medical Officer shall be made by the Director from the persons in the waiting list prepared under rule 5. In cases where there is no person available in the waiting list, the appointment in leave vacancies for a period exceeding six months shall be made by the State Government by nomination.

14. *Transfers.*—The services of any Honorary Medical Officer attached to any Government Hospital or unit thereof in any Municipal Corporation area or other area in any district may be transferred to another Government Hospital or unit in the same area by the Director, regard being had to the needs of the concerned University in that area and the recommendation of such authorities as the Director considers fit to consult:

Provided that, not more than two such transfers shall be effected in any one tenure period of any Honorary Medical Officer.

15. *Duties.*—In addition to the clinical duty and teaching duty if any at the Hospital, every Honorary Medical Officer shall perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the Director, with the prior approval of the State Government.

16. *Disciplinary action.*—Subject to the provisions of these rules, the Bombay Civil Services Conduct, Discipline and Appeal Rules and the rules and order issued by the State Government for maintaining confidential records, from time to time, shall *mutatis mutandis* apply to the Honorary Medical Officers as they apply in relation to Class I Officers of the State Government.

17. *Control.*—All Honorary Medical Officers shall observe the rules of the Government Hospital or Government Medical College in which they are working and shall be subject to the administrative control of the Head of such Hospital or College, as the case may be.

18. *Casual absence.*—In case, any Honorary Medical Officer is unable for any reason to attend the Government Hospital or Government Medical College any time for the performance of his duties, he shall inform the Superintendent in advance to that effect.

19. *Medical Examination.*—Every Honorary Medical Officer shall be required to produce the necessary physical fitness certificate as may be required by the State Government.

20. *Undertaking.*—Every Honorary Medical Officer shall execute an undertaking in writing in the form appended to these rules within three months from the date of commencement of these rules if he is already in service. On failure to execute such undertaking, he shall be deemed to have automatically relinquished the charge of the post held by him on the expiry of the period of three months. A person appointed as Honorary Medical Officer after the date of commencement of these rules shall execute such undertaking before he joins his appointment.

21. *Honorary Consultants.*—(1) The State Government may, from time to time, appoint a person in recognition of his meritorious services in any field of medicine as an Honorary Consultant to any department of a Government Hospital, provided that, the number of such Honorary Consultants shall not ordinarily exceed two at a time in a particular speciality in a hospital.



(2) No person shall be so appointed who is less than 50 years of age and has a standing of less than 25 years in his speciality. The standing in the speciality shall be counted from the year obtaining postgraduate degree or equivalent qualifications in the subject of his speciality. Such appointment of Honorary Consultants shall be for a period of five years in the first instance and renewable for a further period of five years but terminable at the age of 70 years whichever is earlier.

(3) Every Honorary Consultant shall be available for consultation at the specific request of the Superintendent of the Hospital and shall have free access of the Library, Laboratory and other Research facilities available at the Hospital for conduct of any institutional research project. He shall not be called upon to perform any specific clinical duty. However, he shall render advice whenever called upon to do so by the State Government, the Director or the Professor in-charge of the subject or the Head of the speciality, as the case may be.

22. *Professor Emeritus.*—(1) The State Government may appoint any person as Professor Emeritus who has served as a Medical Teacher, either in the capacity of a full-time or in the capacity of an Honorary Professor, whether with Government teaching institution or otherwise, in recognition of his outstanding and meritorious contributions made by him either in the field of medicine or in the profession of teaching, as the case may be to any teaching Hospital attached to a particular Medical College in any subject.

(2) No person shall be so appointed unless he is of 60 years of age and has standing of not less than 30 years in his speciality. All appointments of Professor Emeritus shall be for life.

(3) A Professor Emeritus shall be called upon to deliver a minimum of two lectures per annum on any topic in his speciality to be selected in advance in consultation with the Head of the Medical College concerned and such lectures shall be designed for address to the highest post-graduate students studying in that particular Medical College. He will be entitled to all the privileges of the College and the Hospital to which he is attached like those available to the Honorary Consultant.

23. *Repeal and Saving.*—On the date of commencement of these rules, any corresponding rules or orders or both in force in the State or in any part thereof immediately before such date shall stand repealed, except as respects things done or omitted to be done thereunder before such date.


