Nursing Services at Government Hospitals and Institutions, Nursing Service,
Class III

Government hospitals and institutions in the State will be a composite part of the State Nursing Services, Class III.

The respective appointments of various categories of nurses at the different institutions will be on two separate cadres, i.e., State Cadre for teaching institutions and Regional Cadre, for non-teaching institutions for the purposes of appointments, promotions, transfers, etc. between different hospitals and institutions in the Department.
